

# Remote society lottery licence

Society lotteries can only be run for good causes and cannot be run for private or commercial gain. Local authorities can promote a lottery to raise funds to spend on anything where they have power to incur expenditure.

Regardless of where you are based in the world, you need a licence from us if:

- you are providing facilities for gambling to consumers in Great Britain online (or through any other means of remote communication)
- any part of your remote gambling equipment is based in Great Britain.

There is a remote operating licence for each type of gambling activity you might want to provide.

Depending on the category of licence you apply for, this lets you run a lottery with proceeds of up to **£5 million** for a single draw and aggregate proceeds of **£50 million** in a year (pro-rata limit of £31,311,475 in 2020).

<b>F1</b>	Less than £100,000	£235
<b>G1</b>	£100,000 or greater, up to but excluding £500,000	£352
<b>H1</b>	£500,000 or greater, up to but excluding £10 million	£469
<b>I1</b>	£10 million or greater, up to but excluding £20 million	£1,340
<b>J1</b>	£20 million or greater, up to but excluding £30 million	£2,233
<b>K1</b>	£30 million or greater	£3,572

## Current annual fees

Your first annual fee is due 30 days after your licence is issued and is reduced by 25% (ancillary and linked licence annual fees are not subject to this reduction).

After this, fees are due every year before the anniversary of the day your licence was issued.
